## Publishing your article

## Length of manuscript

Length of text copy max. 11,000 characters (incl. spaces).

Please refrain from submitting overly long articles since that would make reading far more difficult.

Your contributions have to contain the following features:

Check:

- Title: As short as possible and to the point
- Authors: Full name(s) (incl. academic title) and address of the organisation/company. The same applies to co-authors
- Introductory text: About 300 characters (incl. spaces)
- Body of article: About 11,000 characters (incl. spaces). Personal pronouns should be avoided in the text (I, we, us)
- Abbreviations in the text should be avoided as far as possible since they are usually not understandable for everyone
- Tables: Piles of numbers should be avoided unless really necessary; designation “table x “ in text
- Illustrations: About four illustrations are appropriate; designation “Fig. x” in text
- Bibliography: References in the text should be set in square brackets, numbered consecutively in the order in which they appear; bibliographic references as shown in the examples
- The text should be clearly structured (maximum of three headings/subheadings), but the headings should not be numbered
- The text should not contain any reference to numbered headings
- Subheadings should be short

- Don't forget the captions to your photos, illustrations etc.
- Euro always: EUR
- Millions / billions: in German: Mio and Mrd, in English: million and billion
- No separation signs in thousands; e.g. 1000, 10000, **not 10,000**
- No sub-heading immediately after the introductory text

## Submission of material

### Text

1. Please submit the text as Word document file, or, even better, RTF file
2. No formatting should be used (especially no macros, no divisions by manual shifts)
3. Illustrations or graphics should, if possible, not be embedded in text file
4. Tables may be included in the text file or submitted separately as Excel tables as long as there is a clear cross-reference
5. Equations may be directly embedded. They should be consecutively numbered.

### Illustrations

1. Figure files should be in TIF, JPG or in EPS format with TIFF preview
2. Resolution of illustrations in picture files 300 dpi
3. Alternative: PDF files of illustrations
4. No copies or faxes
