BRAUWELT Print and Online

A BRAUWELT subscription also includes the BRAUWELT Brevier – a yearbook that is probably unique in the sector – handy, clear, and so practical it is indispensable.

Reflecting the great international demand for BRAUWELT, it is published in four foreign languages: BRAUWELT International in English (www.brauweltinternational.com), BRAUWELT En Español, BRAUWELT Chinese and BRAUWELT Mir piva i napitkow (BRAUWELT Russian). Fachverlag Hans Carl offers a comprehensive range of information worldwide and reaches decision-makers on-site in their own language.

Subscribers to BRAUWELT International, BRAUWELT Russian, BRAUWELT En Español and BRAUWELT Chinese get the BRAUWELT International Newsletter three times a month. In addition they have access to all articles published in BRAUWELT International since 1999 when logged in to the international online archive. Subscribers to BRAUWELT Mir piva i napitkow also get a Newsletter in Russian once a month.

BrewingScience

The international importance of the BrewingScience specialist journal (www.brewingscience.de) published by Fachverlag Hans Carl is clear from the very name. It is published online first as a scientific organ for the European Brewery Convention (EBC), Brussels, the Wissenschaftsförderung der Deutschen Brauwirtschaft (WiFö), the Center of Life and Food Sciences Weihenstephan, TU München, the Versuchs- und Lehranstalt für Brauerei in Berlin (Research and Teaching Institute for Brewing in Berlin, VLB), the Scientific Station for Brewing in Munich and the Doemens-wba Technikum GmbH in Gräfelfing near Munich. Beside the bimonthly online edition and the printed yearbook, subscribers receive unlimited access to the brewing science database. This makes it possible to search over 30,000 summaries of articles relating to beverage science from every country in the world published since 1963 in BrewingScience, formerly under the name of Monatsschrift für Brauwissenschaft. In addition to the scientific work that is published directly, we keep readers informed with a reader service offering summaries of relevant scientific contributions published in other magazines.

Specialist books from Fachverlag Hans Carl

The company also publishes specialist books in addition to the specialist magazines, to fulfil its role as the information service provider of the brewing industry. The range includes classics such as the Brauerei-Adressbuch, which is updated every two years and is now in its 25th edition, and the series BRAUWELT Wissen, which includes four volumes to date (Ausgewählte Kapitel der Brauereitechnologie, Verfahrenstechnik im Brauprozess, Hopfen – vom Anbau bis zum Bier, Wasser in der Getränkeindustrie).

A whole range of English-language titles was also generated in cooperation with the European Brewery Convention (EBC). These titles bring together science and practice and are a treasury of technical and technological knowledge worldwide. One example is the Analytica EBC, the standard work on methods of analysis which has been published online only and updated on a daily basis since May 2013. The online version replaces the loose sheet collection published before.
